Home Learning

Once again, we are working from home. To ensure that students do not fall behind in this crucial period all students still need to be accessing work from all their subjects to ensure that they retain important knowledge, develop skills and progress through the curriculum whilst we are away from the academy.

Delivery

The delivery of Home Learning will take place using Microsoft Teams. All students have been provided with a Microsoft Teams account is their academy email address and their usual password.

If students cannot log in they will need to contact their head of year to confirm the email address and have their password reset.

Students will follow their normal timetable, which will be populated in Microsoft Teams by the end of Monday 1st November, or can be found on the SIMS parent app.

Students will have a live lesson delivered by their subject teacher of approximately 30 minutes followed by an independent task. Students needs to join the lesson at the beginning of their lesson.

Home Learning Curriculum

Our teachers are adapting the normal curriculum for remote learning to ensure that students are still making progress during this time.

Teachers will deliver the first 30 minutes of the lesson live, explaining key concepts and ideas. The second part of the lesson will be an assignment to consolidate their learning.
